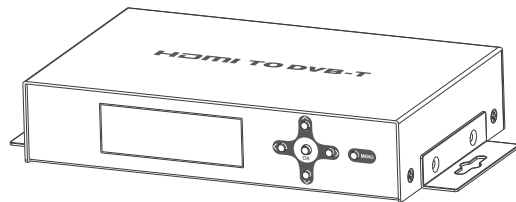


HDMI To DVB-T Converter

User Manual



Please read below safety instructions carefully before installation and operation:

- . Please pay attention to all the warnings and hints on this device.
- . Do not expose this unit to rain, moisture and liquid.
- . Do not put any stuff into the device.
- . Do not repair or open this device without professional people's guidance.
- . Make sure good ventilation openings to avoid product overheating damage.
- . Shut off power and make sure environment is safe before installation.
- . Do not plug-in/out the connected cables when it is in using.
- . Use DC12V/1A power adapter. Make sure the specification matched if using 3rd party DC adapters.

• Product Introduce

This is an HDMI to DVB-T Converter, perfect solution to distribute HDMI signal to DVB-T standard digital cable television via coaxial cables. Output can be set as any channel number and distributed to all the TV's in the system directly via CATV splitter, coexisting with all your current regular channels. Multiple this HDMI to DVB-T converter can be installed to distribute as many channels as you need. It's a perfect solution for monitor systems, outdoor large screen display, shopping mall advertisement, media education fields etc.

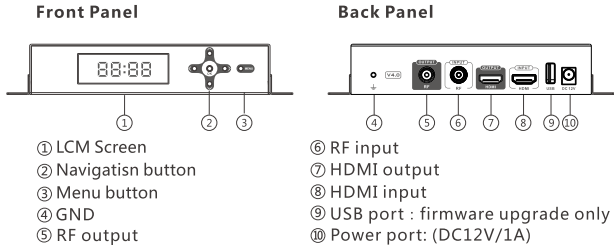
• **Installation**

- 1. Source devices (Device with HDMI Port, like PS3, Set-top box, DVD and PC etc.)
- 2. Display devices (TV with build-in DVB-T, or standard DVB-T Set-top box)
- 3. Cables (26AWG standard HDMI cable, 75-5 [75Ω] standard Coaxial Cable)
- 4. CATV Splitter if needed

- 1. Metal housing, stable and durable
- 2. Wall-mounted function, easy installation
- 3. Strong anti-noise and anti-interference ability
- 4. Support multiple modulators to be installed to distribute as many channels you need
- 5. Distribute one source to multiple displays with one modulator via CATV splitter
- 6. Support DVB-T digital high definition RF signal output
- 7. HDMI input signal resolution up to full HD 1080p@60Hz
- 8. Lightning protection, surge protection, ESD protection

Button introduction

LCM screen: It presents the selected menu and the parameter settings when power on.

Left/Right/Up/Down buttons: use these buttons to turn the screen pages, shift the target items by moving the triangle, or change the parameter settings.

OK button: Use this button to enter a submenu or save a new setting after adjustment.

Menu button: Press this button to enter the main menu interface, or step back.

Below status will be displayed when power on:



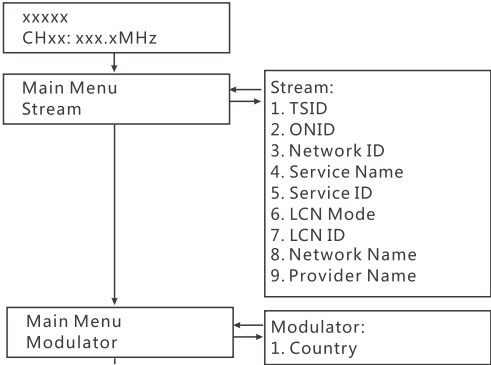
xxxxx: indicate the service name of the device

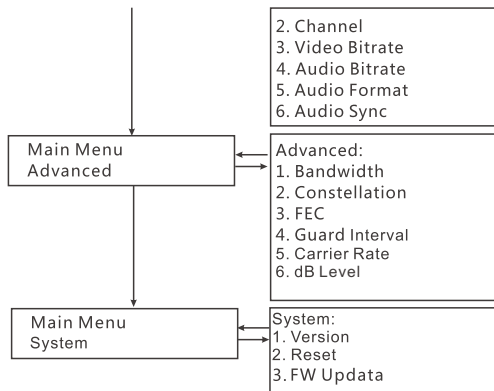
CHxx: indicate the current channel of the device

General setting for Menu

When the power is connected, the LCM menu goes as below chart





All above page/main menu/submenu can be moved/chose/set by the panel button:

- 1) Stream: User can view or adjust TSID(Transport Stream ID),ONID (Original Network ID), Network ID, Service Name, Service ID, LCN (Logical channel number) Mode, LCN ID, Network Name and Provider Name
- 2) Country: User can choose country and area under submenu Modulator, there are fifteen options: France, Greece, Ireland, Germany, UK, Spain, Finland, Sweden, Italy, Denmark, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, New zealand, Australia
- 3) Channel: User can choose Channel under submenu Modulator
- 4) Video Bitrate: Adjust in the range of 1~24Mbps
- 5) Audio Bitrate: Select audio bit rate among 64, 96, 128, 192, 256, 320
- 6) Audio Format: Select audio format between MPEG and AAC

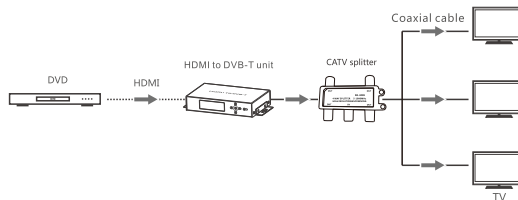
- 7) Audio Sync: Adjust in the range of 1~1000
- 8) Bandwidth: Choose between 6M, 7M and 8M
- 9) Constellation: Choose between 16QAM, 64QAM and QPSK
- 10) FEC: Choose between 1/2, 2/3, 3/4, 5/6, 7/8
- 11) Guard Interval: Choose between 1/4, 1/8, 1/16 or 1/32.
Default is: 1/32
- 12) Carrier Rate: Choose between 2K and 8K
- 13) dB Level: Adjust it at range of -10dBm~+20dBm
- 14) Version: It shows the version information of the device
- 15) Reset: Choose the factory's default configuration
- 16) FW Update: Software upgrade

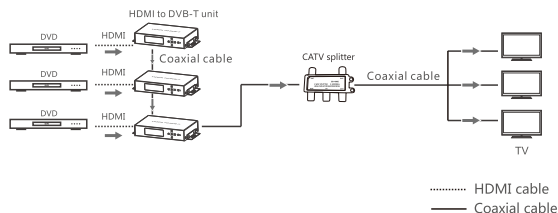
1. Point to point

Connection instructions :

- 1) Step 1- Connect HDMI source device with the HDMI to DVB-T Converter by HDMI cables
- 2) Step 2- Connect the RF output of this HDMI to DVB-T Converter with DVB-T standard digital CATV or set-top box via coaxial cable
- 3) Step 3- Connect with power supply, choose country and channel, this device works

• FAQ

Q: Image is not normal after setting channel (splash screen, disturbance, mosaic etc)?

A: Restart, and make sure coaxial cable connection is stable, or try other channel for testing.

Q: TV displays "NO SIGNAL" on screen?

A: 1) Please check if there is a HDMI signal input;

- 2) Try to connect the signal source directly to display device to see if there is signal output from source device or change the signal source, HDMI wire and try again.
